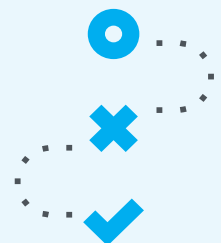

CASE STUDY: UNITED STATES V. POKERSTARS

CHALLENGE: The settlement, involving the remission of approximately \$159 million in forfeited funds, is a result of a civil forfeiture and money laundering action brought against Full Tilt Poker and other internet gambling companies by the DOJ and the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Southern District of New York. GCG received data for over nine million potential claimants involving approximately 13 billion transactions.

RESOLUTION: To manage the volume required in this administration, GCG built a customized online portal that provided claimants the ability to log onto the dedicated case website, using credentials provided by GCG, to review their account balance, file a claim or dispute the account balance, and upload documents in support thereof. To date, GCG has disbursed more than \$114 million in settlement funds.
